The Economist Archives

The USA University Libraries have recently purchased *The Economist Historical Archives* from Gale. *The Economist* was founded in 1843, and it continues to publish commentary, reporting, and analysis on politics, business, science, culture, and technology.

The archive provides access to the full text of the journal from 1843-2015. While using *The Economist* back files, USA patrons can view full-color images, use multiple search indexes, and browse every issue.
