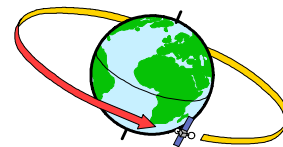

Executive Board Meeting

June 9, 2000

Members present: Robert Avant, Jan Burns, Martha Cook, Pat Higginbottom, Carolyn Holmes, Yvonne Kozlowski, Jie Li, Joan Lukins, Marian Morris, Tracy Powell, Lisa Russell, Ellen Sayed, Diane Williams, Nelle Williams, and Susan Williams.

1. Joan Lukins, President, called the meeting to order at 10:40am.
2. The minutes of the April 2000 Executive Board Meeting were approved as written.
3. Treasurer's Report : Lisa Russell reported on a change to the April report. The current balance is \$9,558.11.
4. Committee Reports
 1. Bylaws : No report.
 2. Continuing Education : Martha Cook reported on proposed topics for the CE courses at SC/MLA 2000. These include: leadership/management, clinical digital libraries, virtual collections, serials, web-site development, nursing resources. One course will be hands-on.
 3. Directory : Jan Burns reported that the new edition will be ready for distribution at the October meeting. C.J. Bryant is working on the membership section. Jan is working on the history and handbook sections; send any corrections on these sections to Jan by July 15th. Jan is also working on getting vendor donations to subsidize the mailing and printing costs.
 4. Liaison : No report.
 5. Membership : Carolyn Holmes reported the we currently have 62 members -- 42 individual and 20 institutional. This includes six new individual members. A motion was passed to changed the membership categories to "Individual" and "Student". The membership dues will be \$15.00 and \$5.00 respectively.
 6. Synapse : Diane Williams announced that the deadline for submissions is June 30th. She will investigate changing the copy service from in-house to the publications department and report back at the next meeting. Currently, USA is covering all printing costs; she will verify this with the director and offer reimbursement if necessary.
 7. Union List Coordinators : Ellen Sayed reported that new DOCLINE is scheduled to be implemented on July 17th. Current LIBIDs will change to new, all alphabetic ones. Robert Avant asked that we keep sending updates to him until the AULS technology changes. There will be meetings later this year to determine the direction of the union list; hopefully, real-time updates will be an option for later. He also reported that the Alabama Virtual Library now includes some 50 databases and has level funding for the coming fiscal year.
 8. Web Coordinator / List Moderator : No report.
 9. Members-at-Large : Yvonne Kozlowski shared several useful items on the Alabama Virtual Library site, including pictures.

 - E Student Scholarship Competition – Final Document Submitted : A copy of the flyer was distributed. For future competitions, only the date information will need to be changed.
 - F Alliance Manual update : Joan reported on information provided by Judy Burnham (also printed in the last issue of *Synapse*). Information on ordering the manual is included on the Alliance website.
 - C. CDC workshop : Congratulations to Martha Cook on putting together a valuable and successful CE course in April.
 - D. 2000 joint meeting with SC/MLA : Susan Williams reported that ALHeLA will have a lunch on Sunday, followed by the business meeting.
 - E. 2001 joint meeting with GHSLA : Pat Higginbottom reported that we have received and accepted the official invitation to hold a joint meeting with GHSLA. The meeting will be held in Columbus, GA, March 14-16, 2001. She distributed brochures on Columbus.

- F. ALHeLA brochure : Carolyn Holmes has designed a new, more elaborate, and more in-depth brochure. She will add a contact phone number. She will investigate printing/publication options and layout options, reporting back at the next meeting.

- B. NAAL/ALHeLA consumer health web instruction project proposal : Susan Williams reported that Sue Medina is interested in putting together additional PubMed instruction courses. There may be left-over grant money to off-set costs. A motion was passed to table discussion until the October meeting.
- C. Scheduling additional board meeting : An additional board meeting was tentatively set for September 8, 2000, 10:30am, at the APLS building in Montgomery.
- D. Other :
1. ALHeLA History poster : Lisa Russell will work on this and recruit others to help her.
 2. ARIEL grant : Joan reported that Mary Fran Prottzman had suggested that some of the ALHeLA libraries might want to participate. Joan will post information on the discussion list.
 3. Southern Expressions : We will submit upcoming conference information and information on the Alliance manual.

VIII. Adjournment : There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:30pm.
