TECHNICAL SERVICES

WHAT IS A NOTIS?

NOTIS, the new online library system at South Alabama, will soon be in full use by library staff. We've been busy inputting serials holdings into the NOTIS format and planning for the changes which will occur when NOTIS is "live." June 27 is the day when the switch from manual to online processing of orders, serials records and cataloging will take place.

We hope that it will not be much longer till the faculty, staff and students who use the Biomedical Library will be able to see NOTIS and become acquainted with the capabilities of this system.

When you see a NOTIS terminal for the first time, take a few minutes to read through the instructions given on the screen. The part of NOTIS which you will see is called LUIS (pronounced Lewis), which is the "user-friendly" public face of the system. NOTIS terminals can be used only to search NOTIS. There is no access to MEDLINE or MUSIC through NOTIS. You can search for books or journals (but not journal articles) by author, title or subject. You will be able to see which volumes and issues of a journal are held by either Biomedical Library location or by the University Library. You will not be able to find out what the Mobile Public Library (or other libraries) own.

To search by subject, you will use MeSH headings, just as you do in our card catalog. Use of the MeSH book to find the correct heading is even more important than ever, because for the present, there are no subject cross references in LUIS.

We think you'll like NOTIS as much as we do.

SPOTLIGHT ON: BIOETHICS

The Bioethics database, which is produced by the Kennedy Institute of Ethics at Georgetown University, is the online version of the Bibliography of Bioethics. The database includes citations to a variety of types of materials which discuss the ethical and public policy aspects of such topics as reproductive technology, genetic intervention, mental health therapies and human experimentation. Bioethics, which is a comprehensive list of English-language materials published from 1973 to the present, is available through the National Library of Medicine online network. HISTORY OF MEDICINE

Medical Obituaries: American Physicians' Biographical Notices in Selected Medical Journals Before 1907. Lizabeth M. Holloway: Garland Pub. Inc.: 1981.

With the advent of the AMA directories in 1906 biographical data for American physicians alive after that year is rather easy to find. However before that time, no ready source exists for American medical biography in one single work. Most of the biographical data can be found in the thousands of volumes of journals and proceedings of societies, however their indexes are inadequate or often completely lacking. Thus a researcher's job is made even more complicated.

The present work aims to fill this gap. The author states it "must be regarded as only a springboard toward further research, and not in any sense a work of completeness or authority." However, it's a good start and of value to librarians, researchers, and persons interested in professional and personal history. The author also hopes "it will encourage further and more comprehensive compilations."
