## NATIONAL LIBRARY OF MEDICINE NEWS

### Regional Medical Library Program Reconfiguration

With passage of the Medical Library Assistance Act of 1965, the Regional Medical Library Program was authorized. The United States was divided into eleven regions creating a biomedical communications network. Each region has a central or regional library through which the members work. The A. W. Calhoun Medical Library of Emory University serves as the regional library for Region 6 in which the Biomedical Library participates.

Because of current and anticipated budget constraints, the National Library of Medicine (NLM) will reduce the number of regions from eleven to seven in November 1982. The Mid-Atlantic Region (Region 4) and the Southeastern Region (Region 6) will merge. The Health Science Library of the University of Maryland will become the new regional library.

Along with the reconfiguration the National Library of Medicine has revised the Regional Medical Library Program's mission statement that says it shall:

"Provide health sciences practitioners, investigators, educators and administrators in the United States with timely, convenient access to health care and biomedical information resources. The Program is coordinated by the National Library of Medicine and carried out through a nationwide network of health-sciences libraries and information centers."

The Program's goals "emphasize the provision of information to health professionals, the use of modern technologies to provide this information in a timely, cost-effective manner, and the necessity for cooperation and sharing among health science libraries and information centers." #### STAFF NEWS

Geneva Bush participated in an Alabama Academy of Family Physicians/ Department of Family Practice seminar on September 18, 1982. The title of her slide presentation was "Library Resources: Who Uses Them, For What Purpose."

## TECHNICAL SERVICES

### The Card Catalog: Are Its Days Numbered?

At the University of South Alabama Libraries the answer is "Yes!", but we have no predictions as to the length of time it will remain with us. We hope that all of you will mourn its passing as little as we will.

The Biomedical Library, within the next few months will be undergoing, along with the University Library, a rather dramatic change in behind-the-scenes work methods and procedures.

Last year, the Libraries purchased the software for the NOTIS system from Northwestern University. The system (NOTIS stands for Northwestern Online Total Integrated System) provides for automation of many library functions such as book ordering, cataloging and serials check in. Programs for the circulation function, which is one of the oldest modules of the system, are currently being rewritten by Northwestern staff.

One of the most welcome, and we think, exciting results of NOTIS is an online public access capability, called LUIS (Library User Information Service) which is planned to eventually replace the old, familiar, and crowded card catalog.

In the not too distant future, a user will be able to walk into the library, type a portion of an author's name on a terminal screen and receive a display listing works by that person or organization which are held by either the Biomedical or University Libraries. Subject and title access to holdings records will also be possible.

The database will include journals and other serials held by both libraries as well as microforms, audiovisuals and ultimately, government documents. We expect that the serials printouts with their sometimes confusing representations of holdings will probably be retired long before the card catalogs are put to rest. Unambiguous holdings statements are planned for the new system.

Northwestern enjoys a dial-up capability with terminals in remote locations. A researcher here may eventually be able to consult a terminal in the lab or office to see if the library has a needed journal or book.

Testing of the system is under way. Staff training and "live" use of the system is still some weeks in the future. Watch forthcoming issues of BIOFEEDBACK for announcements of the status of NOTIS implementation.

We are excited about the opportunities NOTIS provides to offer more effective service to the University community. We look forward to showing LUIS to you all.

#### REFERENCE NOTES

##### National Committee for Clinical Laboratory Standards

Incorporated in 1968, the National Committee for Clinical Laboratory Standards is an interdisciplinary, nonprofit organization formed to promote the development and use of national and international standards that are needed for improved operation of clinical laboratories. The standards include specifications for biological and chemical reagents or reference materials, reference methods or procedures, operating methods, controls for equipment, or other applicable matters.

The NCCLS represents industry, government, and the professions. It develops, evaluates, and seeks field consensus on written specifications in these nine areas: clinical chemistry, evaluation protocols, hematology, immunohematology-blood banking, instrumentation, labeling, ligand assay, microbiology, toxicology/drug monitoring. A "Proposed Standard" and a "Tentative Standard" take more than a year of review before the publication is issued as an "Approved Standard".

The Biomedical Library has a corresponding membership with the NCCLS and thus receives a copy of all the Committee's standards--proposed, tentative, and approved. They are located in the Vertical File at the Campus location.

#### ONLINE SERVICES DEPARTMENT

At the present time, the Biomedical Library has access to approximately 70 different databases through the NLM and BRS information systems. In each edition of BIOFEEDBACK, we will be highlighting one of the less well-known databases which might be of interest to our patrons. Anyone who wants more information about a particular database can contact me at the Campus location of the Biomedical Library.

#### SPOTLIGHT ON: Family Resources Database

The Family Resources Database which is produced by the National Council of Family Relations is a unique interdisciplinary database which covers the literature of marriage and the family from 1970 to date.

The database comes from two sources. One is the inventory of Marriage and Family, an index of over 800 journals on marriage and family topics. The second source of documents is the Family Resource and Referral Center, a clearinghouse that identifies and disseminates information relevant to the family. Because the database is produced from a resource center's files, it contains materials which range from books and government publications to audiovisuals.

Biomedical Library searchers have found this database to be particularly useful for doing those searches which deal with the families of people with specific conditions or diseases.
