He served as distinguished professor of Anatomy at the University of South Alabama College of Medicine from 1975 until his death in Mobile on March 17, 1981. Goss was editor of Gray's Anatomy for nearly 30 years and editor-in-chief of the Anatomical Record from 1948-1968.

Biomedical Library Nationally Ranked

Search Committee - Head of Biomedical Library - Update

The search committee for the new "Associate Director of Libraries and Head of the Biomedical Library" has been hard at work reviewing applications. The field has been narrowed to four candidates. The candidates will be interviewed during March and April. Hopefully, an appointment will be forthcoming.

Inflation - Acquisitions Curtailed

Inflation is perhaps the library's worst enemy and biggest problem. Due to the combination of basic inflation in journal subscription prices and the increases in foreign subscriptions caused by devaluation of the dollar abroad, fewer subscriptions are being added to the collection. A close look will be made at the number of duplicate subscriptions and titles that are seldom used before the current titles are renewed in the fall. To help in the decision-making, the Serials Department, with the help of the Circulation Department, has begun a use-study of the journals collection. Before any titles are cut, communications will be made with the administration and faculty. See future issues of BIOFEEDBACK.
